

**Notice of Proposed Rate Increase
To Customers of the
Old Town Water District**

The Old Town Water District Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 7, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Old Town Public Library located at 46 Middle Street, to discuss and receive comments on a proposed rate increase being filed with the Maine Public Utilities Commission to be effective July 1, 2019.

The total annual increase requested is \$34,418 which represents an increase of 2.00% over current rates. The dollar amount and percentage rate increase by customer class is as follows:

Metered accounts:

Industrial	\$642	2.2937%
Public fire protection charges	\$6,867	1.3212%

Public Fire Protection rates are determined pursuant to Chapter 690 of the Public Utilities Commission Rules. The District is proposing to increase utility rates to cover increases in debt service from water main replacement projects. The Districts last rate increase of 16.00% occurred on July 1, 2018.

Pursuant to regulation 35-A-M.R.S.A. section 6104-A, any customer has the right to request additional information relating to the present and proposed rates from the Water District, the right to an open and fair hearing, and the right to seek assistance from the Public Advocate's office.
