The total annual increase requested is \$36,977.88 which represents an increase of 2.00% over current rates. The dollar amount and percentage rate increase by customer class is as follows:

Public Fire Protection rates are determined pursuant to Chapter 690 of the Public Utilities Commission Rules. The District is proposing to increase utility rates to cover increases in debt service from water main replacement projects. The Districts last rate increase of 2.25% occurred on October 1, 2020.

Pursuant to regulation 35-A-M.R.S.A. section 6104-A, any customer has the right to request additional information relating to the present and proposed rates from the Water District, the right to an open and fair hearing, and the right to seek assistance from the Public Advocate's office.
