Our Public Water System Has Completed an Initial Service Line Inventory

As required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Old Town Water District has completed the initial water service line inventory on October 10, 2024, Old Town Water District has classified the water service line supplying your address as either lead, galvanized requiring replacement (GRR), or as lead status unknown service line (material of line unknown).

The water service line material classifications for the customer-owned portion and the system-owned portion can be publicly viewed at our office located at 109 Center Street, Old Town.

The Old Town Water District is continuing to resolve these unknown water service line materials. **You can help by emailing a photo of the water service line as it enters the building to Service@oldtownwater.org.** The water service line is the pipe generally located in the basement and is located just below the brass or white plastic water meter and passes through the floor or wall. The picture should include the service line entering the building, and the water meter if possible. Please include your name, property location and phone number in the email with the photo submission to Service@oldtownwater.org.
